It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-17.1 of the General Laws entitled "Department of
- 2 Environmental Management" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>42-17.1-45. No prohibition on pets. -- (a)Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter</u>
- 4 to the contrary, the department shall not promulgate or enforce any rule or regulation that would
- 5 prohibit a pet dog or cat from accompanying its owner or caretaker at any state owned
- 6 <u>campground.</u>
- 7 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, nothing in this
- 8 section shall be deemed to allow pets within any state beach facility that includes a bathing beach
- 9 <u>licensed by the department of health pursuant to chapter 23-21, unless the bathing beach portion</u>
- of the facility is sufficiently isolated from other public areas within the facility.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
